DISTRICT MAPS CHANGE

In Marin County, the Board of Supervisors is responsible for drawing supervisorial districts based on U.S. Census data and input from County residents. Our redistricting process must be completed by December 15, 2021. The final district map created through this process will determine supervisorial district boundaries for the next 10 years.



Describing your community of interest is the first step to identifying where you want district borders to begin and end. Questions to consider include:

- Where is your community located? Be as specific as possible about the boundaries.
- What are your shared interests? What is important to your community?
- Why should your community be kept together for fair and effective representation?
- What nearby areas does your community want to, or not want to, be grouped with?
